What is it?

1,000 Books Before Kindergarten is a non-profit program which encourages the development of children's early literacy skills before Kindergarten by reading to the children.

How do I participate?

This program is easy to participate in! Every time you read to your child or your child hears a story record it in the reading log! Write down the title of the book and color in the duck. Does your child have that one book they want to read over and over again? You can repeat titles as often as your child wants to hear it! Once the log is complete, you can bring the log back to the library and your child will receive a rubber duck from our prize chest! Don't forget to pick up a new reading log!

No need to be scared of the numbers! Just think of it this way! If you read 1 book every night for 365 days a year then you already have 365 books down! Then in 2 years it would be 730 books, and 1,095 books in just 3 years!!
