Explore the beautiful gardens and sculptures of Grounds for Sculpture in Hamilton NJ. Borrow our pass that admits up to 4 people.

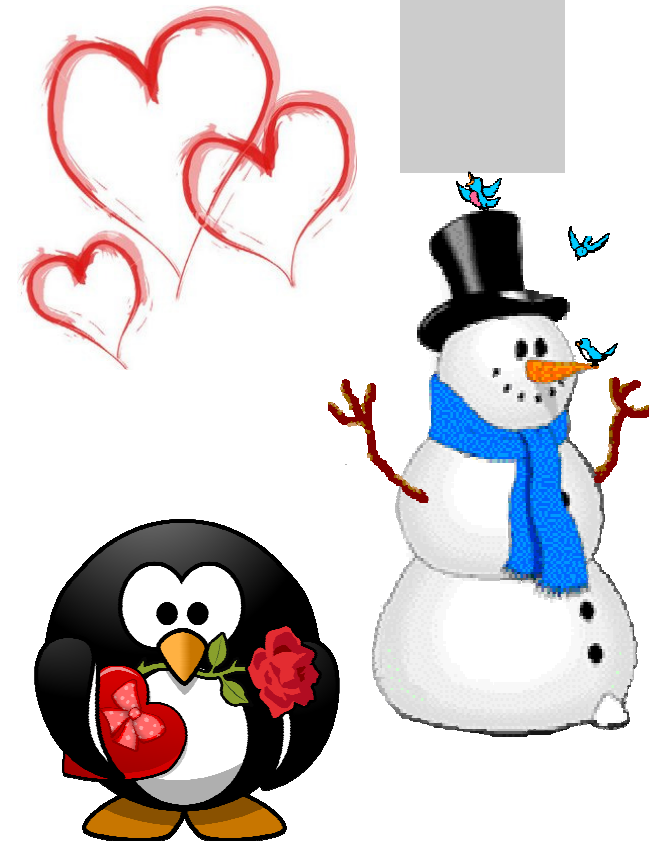
